Opened in 2010, the Ralph Regula federal building was constructed to replace two facilities: the 70-year old Frank T. Bow Federal Building and the Social Security Administration. The 45,000 square-foot space is composed of two brick buildings connected by a 34-foot-high glass-atrium lobby. The new building is LEED silver certified.

Hilscher-Clarke's scope of work involved the electrical and communications portions of the project. Our dedicated electricians installed the audio and video/controls systems, security wiring, interior and exterior lighting, wiring devices, floor boxes, generator and automatic transfer switch, elevator wiring, fire alarm system, and electrical distribution equipment. This project was unique due to the specialty requirements of a government building.
